






#### Belief #1


People are more important than processes and products.

At this time God's cause is in need of men and women who possess rare qualifications and good administrative powers:


 Men and women who will make patient, thorough investigation of the needs of the work in various fields







- 2. Those who have a large capacity for work

- Those who are sanctified by the Spirit of God and can fearlessly say, No, or Yea and Amen, to propositions






















# Transformational **Leader**

How would you describe a spiritual leader?




My most important appointment today is my appointment

with God.

Consecrate yourself to God in the morning; make this your very first work.

Let your prayer be, "Take me, O Lord, as wholly Thine. I lay all my plans at Thy feet. Use me today in Thy service.

Abide with me, and let all my work be wrought in Thee."



"This is a daily matter.

Each morning consecrate yourself to God for that day.

Like the disciples, we are in danger of losing sight of our dependence on God, and seeking to make a savior of our activity.


We need to look constantly to Jesus, realizing that it is His power which does the work.


## The Desire of Ages, p. 362

Only the work accomplished with much prayer, and sanctified by the merit of Christ, will in the end prove to have been efficient for good.








































































#### Philippians 2:3-7
